construction work on land and homes damaged by Hurricane Harvey in 2017 in the Coastal Bend Area in South Texas. Volunteer understands that the Activities may include hard physical labor, heavy lifting, exposure to hazardous materials and conditions, work on ladders, exposure to the elements, interaction with dangerous wildlife, including poisonous snakes or insects and other circumstances that may result in personal injuries.

Volunteer hereby freely, voluntarily, and without duress executes this Release under the following terms:

1. <u>Release and Waiver</u>. Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge and hold harmless CBDRG and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity, that arise or may hereafter arise from Volunteer's Activities with CBDRG.

VOLUNTEER UNDERSTANDS THAT THIS RELEASE DISCHARGES CBDRG FROM ANY LIABILITY OR CLAIM THAT THE VOLUNTEER MAY HAVE AGAINST CBDRG WITH RESPECT TO ANY BODILY INJURY, PERSONAL INJURY, ILLNESS, DEATH, OR PROPERTY DAMAGE THAT MAY RESULT FROM VOLUNTEER'S ACTIVITIES WITH CBDRG, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF CBDRG OR ITS OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, CONTRACTORS, EMPLOYEES, OR AGENTS OR OTHERWISE. VOLUNTEER ALSO UNDERSTANDS THAT CBDRG DOES NOT ASSUME ANY RESPONSIBILITY FOR OR OBLIGATION TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OR OTHER ASSISTANCE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO MEDICAL, HEALTH, OR DISABILITY INSURANCE IN THE EVENT OF INJURY OR ILLNESS.

- 2. <u>Medical Treatment</u>. Volunteer does hereby release and forever discharge CBDRG from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with Volunteer's Activities with CBDRG.
- 3. <u>Assumption of the Risk</u>. Volunteer understands that the Activities may involve work that may be hazardous to Volunteer, including, but not limited to, outdoor construction work, debris removal, demolition of structures, construction activities, and transportation to and from the work sites, and the other conditions set forth above. Volunteer certifies that he/she is in good health and physically able to perform this type of work. Volunteer hereby expressly and specifically assumes the risk of injury or harm in the Activities, and releases CBDRG from all liability for injury, illness, death, or property damage resulting from the Activities.
- 4. <u>Accommodations</u>. In the event the CBDRG arranges accommodations, Volunteer understands that CBDRG is not responsible or liable for Volunteer's personal effects and property and that CBDRG will not provide lock-up or security for any items. Volunteer further understands that he/she is to abide by whatever rules and regulations may be in effect for the accommodations at the time. Volunteer will hold the CBDRG harmless in the event of theft, or for loss resulting from any source or cause.
- 5. <u>Insurance</u>. Volunteer understands that, except as otherwise agreed to by CBDRG in writing; CBDRG does not carry or maintain health, medical, or disability insurance coverage for any Volunteer. Each Volunteer is expected and encouraged to obtain his or her own medical or health insurance coverage.
- 6. <u>Confidentiality</u>. Volunteer acknowledges the need for confidentiality and will not discuss, photograph or otherwise disclose identifying information about the occupants of the home or land Volunteer works on without prior written permission from the CBDRG and the land owner. This includes any reference to names, addresses, or other identifying information.
- 7. <u>Photographic Release</u>. Volunteer does hereby grant and convey unto CBDRG all right, title, and interest in any and all photographic images and video or audio recordings made by CBDRG during Volunteer's Activities with CBDRG, including, but not limited to, any royalties, proceeds, or other benefits derived from such photographs or recordings.
- 8. Other. Volunteer expressly agrees that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Texas and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of Texas. Volunteer also agrees that in the event that any clause or provision of this Release shall be held to be invalid by any court of law, the remaining provisions of this Release shall continue to be enforceable.
